FHQTC CLOSING ALL OFFICES TO THE PUBLIC AS PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC. ESSENTIAL SERVICES TO REMAIN OPERATIONAL

(Treaty 4 Territory) By order of FHQ Tribal Council Leadership, the File Hills Qu'Appelle Tribal Council will close all offices to the public as precautionary measures to the COVID-19 pandemic at 12 noon until further notice. However, essential services will remain operational.
