- Doba sam haḡe eha I  
Four over half we have reached  
It is 4:30.



- Age wazi sam haḡe  
11 over half we have reached.  
It is 11:30.



- Makiyutabi – kilometers  
Destination + kilometers

- How far is Regina?  
Huhuzubina makiyutabi  
Wikcemna saknoğa  
Regina is 80kms/distance away.
- Hokuwa o'inaz makiyutabi  
Wikcemna doba  
Fort Qu'appelle is 40kms/distance away.

### Foot

- Tacakiyutabi  
  
Haska – s/he is tall.  
Mahaska – I am tall  
Nihaska – you are tall.
- Hoksina ne tacakiyutabi zapta haska  
This boy is 5 feet tall.
- Tacakiyutabi sakpe mahaska  
I am 6 feet tall.



- Tacakiyutabi doba ni haska  
You are 4 feet tall.
- Eha I – s/he has reached a certain place or time.
- Dona haska eha ya i  
How much long/tall have you reached.  
How tall are you?
- Tacakiyutabi sakpe ehawa'i  
I am 6 feet tall.
